### 1. Book Example

### 2. Article Example

Author's Name. "Title of Article." Periodical Name Day Month Year: pages. Medium.

"Ways to Cheaply Purify Water in Developing Countries." *The Water Source* 12 June 2011: 23-25. Print.

### 3. Internet Example

Author's Name. "Article Name." *Web Site Title*. Publisher information, posting date. Medium. Date material was accessed. URL if required/for your personal reference.

Note: n.p.=no publisher provided, n.d.=no publication date provided
